### **Baby Dog 2 entries**

#### 1. RALUN VERSACE            R Pierce

Really beautiful puppy, full of promise, could have taken him home with me. Super head, coat, angles & outline & the confidence to go with it. Loved everything about him – will be interested to see the adult version, so may have to come back!

#### 2. WILLOWBROOK LEADING EDGE        D Turner

Very close decision between these 2 boys – on the day this boy didn't quite have the angles of 1. Nevertheless a super quality puppy with a pleasing head, lovely bone & feet & a confident attitude. Well handled & presented.

### **Minor dog 4 entries**

#### 1. CLAIREDOREE MONTEGO BAY        L & B Evans

Beautiful boy who did his utmost to throw this class away, but could not be denied his place. His handler's patience paid dividends & by the end of the day he was much more settled & I was delighted to award him BPIS. Quality all through with balanced gentle head, good bone, tight feet, & a level topline which he held on the move, & powerful well angulated quarters.

Nicely presented in pretty pale gold coat with cream feathering

2. CHALEUR NO NONSENSE R Thompson

Promising quality puppy with lovely head, kind dark eye & super pigmentation. Clean classic outline. At this stage he hadn't quite got the substance of 1. but is younger & has time to develop. Best of toplines & tailsets, moved out well for his age.

3. NYRRAE UR UN'QUE R Rayner

Nice puppy with pleasing balanced head, straight front, well up on his pasterns, short coupled body, no exaggerations. At the stage where he needs to drop into his angles to complete the picture.

**Puppy dog** 4 entries 1scratched

Difficult class with 3 very different puppies, all at different stages of development.

1. WESTROVA ALPHA QUENTIN F Strover

Although not in the best of coats this mid-gold boy won the class on his excellent accurate movement. Balanced all through, nicely boned with neat feet, super topline & tailset. Another who is right for his age & now needs time to drop into himself.

2. FAIRYRING INSTANT KARMA P & A & S

Reader

Close decision between 1 & 2. Lovely happy waggy boy with excellent pigment, good reach of neck & overall balance. Just needs to tighten up in movement as he matures & muscles up.

3. CLAIREDOREE MONTE CARLO K Blake

Nice boy with super angles shown in pretty pale gold wavy coat. Pleasing gentle head with good pigment, has all the essentials, just needs time to body up & mature. Well handled.

**Junior dog** 4entries

Lovely class of 4 promising youngsters.

With this breeding & handler, this boy needed to give 110% to win & he did! Gentle chiselled head with kind dark eye, super black pigment, good strong straight bone & neat feet. Long neck with well laid shoulders, level topline & tailset, balanced all through. Moved out well with super head & tail carriage. Loved everything about him, wish he was mine.

2. WANNTREE REBELS REPLICA

Quality mid-gold boy with lovely gentle head & excellent pigment. Super bone & feet, deep through chest, balanced flowing outline, covered the ground well.

3. SWIFTTREVE ICE DIAMOND

J Brown

Very much the baby of the class. Nicely constructed boy with pleasing head, good reach of neck, super angles & level topline & tailset. Just needs to gain confidence & mature to reach his full potential.

**Intermediate dog** 8 entries

1. DOBRO DIAMOND EDGE

Strong upstanding well made cream boy with gentle masculine head & good pigment. Pleasing outline, well angulated upper arm/shoulder, strong topline with correct tailset. Nicely presented & handled to advantage.

2. WANNTREE PERFECT STORM

E Griffiths

Very nicely constructed boy who just needs to body up to fill his frame. Gorgeous gentle head with kind eye & alert expression. Good front assembly with neck flowing into level topline. Well bent stifles with short strong rear pasterns which he used to advantage on the move.

3. SHOGOLD JEAN LUC

S Jewell / S

MacKenzie

Nicely presented mid-gold boy, shown in good condition. Short coupled & balanced all through with good bone & neat feet. Moved out with good reach maintaining his topline.

**State bred dog 8 entries**

1. CH CHALEUR CODE OV SILENCE

R Thompson

Top quality boy who could hold his own anywhere. Stunning clean outline, lovely gentle head with regal expression. Everything I was looking for, good lay of shoulder & length of upper arm, super bone & feet, well bent stifles with strong well let down hocks. Covered the ground effortlessly with super head carriage giving him such ring presence – the X factor required to reach the top spot. A worthy DCC winner & BIS

2. CH SWIFTTREVE PURE MISCHIEF

Nicely balanced mid-gold boy, carrying just the right amount of weight & condition. Beautifully proportioned head with dark pigment & kind eye & expression. Good muscular neck flowing into level topline. Straight well boned front assembly, well up on pasterns. Good width of second thigh giving strong driving movement.

3. NYRRAE TANITHS TOYBOY

Mature boy shown in gleaming rich gold coat with pale feathering.

Pleasing head with good pigment. Nicely put together with superb rear quarters.

**Aust bred dog 4 entries**

1. CH AMBERMIST GRAND DESIGN

Partridge kennels

Close decision between 1 & 2. Compact balanced top notch pale gold boy, beautifully presented & handled to advantage. Lovely typical head, good clean neck, well angulated shoulder & upper arm, strong topline & tailset, good width of second thigh. Covered the ground with ease.

2. CH KAPARLA WHO SAYS SO

R Thompson

Superbly constructed dog just looking a little tucked up in the loin today. Gentle head, super reach of neck, excellent angulation fore & aft. Moved with a long easy stride. Bodied up in full coat he could trouble the best.

3. CONARHU GONWITH THE WIND

Lovely type shown in gleaming rich gold coat. Gentle masculine head, super flow of neck, good bend of stifle & well angulated rear hocks. Good level mover.

**Open dog 9 entries**

Was really surprised when I read the catalogue & discovered who this stunning boy was. Bears no resemblance to the callow youth that left our shores! Has matured into a beautiful dog, now in his prime. Loved the way he combines elegance with strength, totally

Nightmare class in which I really needed 6 blue ribbons, there was so little to chose between these 6 little stars, all a real credit to their owners.

1. WILLOWBROOK DIAMOND EYES L  
Reid

Think she's been here before! Stood stock still 4 square saying pick me! Sweetest of heads & expression, long flowing neck, nicely angulated front & rear, full of promise.

2. RALUN VERY STYLISH R Pierce

And she was! Full of quality with a happy wagging tail. Very pretty with an alert expression, good bone, neat feet, nice angles –

super!

3. WESTROVA ALPHA TIGERLILY F  
Strover

Miss personality plus! Win or lose this young lady was determined to enjoy her day out. Lurking under that enormous puppy coat was a very nicely constructed puppy with a good reach of neck, super bone & feet, level topline & good angles. Another I could have taken home.

**Minor bitch** 7 entries

1. DOBRO DIAMANTINA C O'Donnell  
Beautifully balanced pale gold girl, full of quality. Feminine head with happy alert expression. Good reach of neck, straight front, nicely boned, balanced angulation front & rear. Moved out well for her age.

2. FAIRYRING LINDERELLA L Reader  
Lovely chiselled head with gentle expression enhanced by excellent pigmentation. Balanced all through with good reach of neck. Moved with good head carriage.

3. PIARKI TOFFEE APPLE N Brown  
Still very much a baby but with a lovely clean eye catching outline. Pretty head with good pigment, kind dark expressive eyes. Super reach of neck into level topline & tailset, sympathetically handled.

**Puppy bitch** 8 entries 1 scratched

Close decision between 3 lovely puppies

1. AMBERMIST JUST DEVINE Partridge  
Kennels

Elegant pretty bitch shown in smooth pale gold coat. Very feminine head, excellent reach of neck & layback, good length of upper arm. Well bent stifles with good width of second thigh. Impressive outline on the move.

2. CLAIREDOREE MOON GLOW A Kumar  
Very promising puppy with gorgeous head & alert 'full of it' expression. Well boned forelegs, right up on pasterns with neat feet, well angulated rear. Not in as good coat as 1.

3. SWIFTTREVE CELEBRATION J Bliss  
Lovely quality puppy with pretty head & excellent pigment. Nicely presented in pale gold coat with cream feathering. Good flow of neck, well constructed front. Just standing a bit 'bum high' however when she matures & drops into her stifles she should trouble the best.

**Junior bitch** 7 entries

1. CHALEUR KARISMA J Grieve / R  
Thompson

Really lovely mid-gold girl, balanced all through. Very pretty head with super pigment & kindly expression. Good length of neck flowing into level topline & tailset. Best of fronts with good length & angulation of blade & upper arm. Strong quarters with well bent stifles. Another I would like to see when she's mature.

2. DEWMIST SILVERLING R Thompson  
Quality elegant cream girl with scopey frame which is going to take time to fill. Gentle chiselled head with black pigmentation.



Nicely balanced angles front & rear, very elegant mover.

3. SWIFTTREVE JUST YOUANME

J Brown

Big well boned girl who looked a bit out of place in this class but who should come into her own as she moves into higher classes. Pleasing head with super pigment & kindly expression. Lovely flowing outline with powerful quarters which she used to advantage on the move.

**Intermediate bitch 8 entries**

1. FANTANGO JUST THE TICKET

Immature but with a stunning outline & promise of things to come. Happy showgirl with gentle expression, good bone, straight front & balanced angles. Moved well covering the ground with a long easy stride.

2. RONJALEE REET PETITE OF FERNAVY [IMP

Close contender, unfortunately not in her Sunday best. Very pretty feminine head, super reach of neck, well angulated fore & aft with good layback of shoulders. Short well angulated rear pasterns, presented a very pleasing outline.

3. GOLDCITY SHAKIRAH DAWN

Nicely balanced mid-gold girl with well placed shoulders, good length of upper arm & level topline & tailset. Nicely presented.

**State bred bitch 4 entries**

1. CH WILLOWBROOK HOT TAMARLI

Turner

Loved the type & balance of this mid-gold girl. Gorgeous head with super black pigment, long clean neck flowing into level topline. Super bone with neat feet, balanced angulation front & rear. Worthy Champion.

2. CLAIREDOREE ANZAC BELLS JD AD A

Very elegant outline, lovely head & expression, straight front, balanced all through. Moved out accurately covering the ground with ease.

3. CH CHALEUR VALENTINE R Thompson

Elegant bitch with attractive feminine head & balanced outline. Not in the best of coats.

Beautifully constructed rich gold bitch who moved out with drive to win the class. Gentle head with kind expression & super dark pigment. Superbly angulated front with tight elbows, well boned with neat feet. Excellent reach of neck into level topline. Strong quarters used to advantage on the move.

2. GR CH SHOGOLD BOLD N BEAUTIFUL S

Balanced smaller bitch, well presented & handled, unfortunately not in full coat. Gentle feminine head, good reach of neck, level topline & tailset, strong well angulated quarters.

3. CH MONTEGO CHRISTABELLE A Kumar

Lovely quality cream girl with pretty feminine head & good

pigment. Nicely flowing neck, good length of upper arm. Just carrying a bit too much weight.

**Open bitch** 6 entries 1 scratched

1. CH GILTEDGE TARA S & K Handley  
Beautiful bitch with stunning outline shown in gleaming gold coat with pale feathering. Gentle feminine head with trusting expression. Superb reach of neck & layback of shoulder. Good length of upper arm, dead level topline. Well angulated quarters providing strong driving movement. All this and a wagging tail! A superb bitch anyone would be very proud to own. CC and RUBIS.

2. NUSWIFT CLASSIC MERCEDES N  
Brown  
Very neat balanced little lady with straight front, super angles, lovely length & flow of neck & good width of second thigh. An accurate mover, handled to advantage RCC

3. CH SWIFTTREVE CAELEIGH J Brown  
Very similar in shape & type to 2, but not in full coat & as yet lacks the maturity for top honours in this company. However a very attractive well constructed girl with all the essentials, who just needs time to come to her best.
